0.5	Users and Application	The main users of the statistical information are the state government and local self-government bodies, public, scientific educational, financial organizations, business society, mass media, international organizations, etc. Information on the activities of the institutions providing services to the aged and disabled is applied for the purpose of strategy development in the mentioned field, solutions of the strategic tasks, and other purposes.
0.6	Information Sources	The main source of information compilation is data collected from the annual statistical reports from the institutions providing services to the aged and disabled.
0.7	Legal Authority to Collect Data	The data are collected based on the Law on "Official Statistics" and "Five Year Statistical Program", as well as the Resolution No. 05-N of RA State Council on Statistics "On Approval of the Procedure for the collection of statistical data" dated 20 June 2016 and Resolution "On Approval of Annual Statistical Program".

1.2	Statistical concepts	<p>Main Concepts</p> <p>Persons in care a person who receives twenty four hour social protection at the residential care institutions (retirement homes).</p> <p>Retirement homes institutions providing twenty four hour care and social services to the aged or disabled persons.</p> <p>Care is provided to those family members who are unable to care for themselves or the persons who have reached the pension age and cannot live independently and on younger</p>

		<p>individuals (18 years of age and above) who have disabilities. The care is provided by social protection or other specialized institutions.</p> <p>Universal homes (residential institutions) are intended for a long term stay of the aged people who are unable to care for themselves as well as the disabled persons (18 years of age and over) aimed at providing care, social services and permanent shelter.</p> <p>Special protection institutions provide all day long care, social services and permanent shelter to the population at 18 years of age and over, who are suffering from mental disorders, are mentally under developed, to the aged people suffering from psychical disorders and serious form of sclerosis.</p> <p>Groupings for Publication</p> <p>The data on the activities of the institutions providing social services to the aged and disabled people are published by public and non-public institutions, sex and age groups of the aged and disabled, sex and educational level of the staff.</p>
