0.4	Purpose and History	To provide users with annual information on sanitary cleaning of urban communities area. The calculation of indicator has a long history and has been maintained since 1960s. It has been regularly improved throughout the years to ensure the comparability with international classifications, composition of indicators and other standards.
0.5	Users and Application	The main users of statistical information are the state government and local self-government bodies, public, scientific-educational, financial organizations, business society, mass media, international organizations, etc. Information on sanitary cleaning of urban community areas is applied in the field of urban development for the purposes of strategy development, solutions of strategic tasks, revealing social development trends and other purposes.
0.6	Information Sources	The main source of indicator compilation is data collected from municipalities and legal persons carrying out automatic sanitary cleaning works through statistical reports.
0.7	Legal Authority to Collect Data	The data are collected based on the Law on "Official Statistics" and "Five Year Statistical Program", as well as the Resolution No. 05-N of RA State Council on Statistics "On Approval of the Procedure for the collection of statistical data" dated 20 June 2016 and Resolution "On Approval of Annual Statistical Program".

1.1	Description of content	<p>Sanitary cleaning of urban areas is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) the number of cars of special designation according to types, b) the total number of cars-days, including the ones under repair, in the process of conservation, hours of non- operation due to meteorological conditions and other reasons, c) volume of wastes transferred solid wastes and liquid residuals, the volume of snow and other loads d) receipt and use of financial means, e) debts accumulated during the years, including from population, f) average listed number of employees
1.2	Statistical concepts	<p>Main concepts</p> <p>Total number of cars-days is calculated as a sum of multipliers of the cars of organization and the number of days of the reporting year. The number of cars-days during work is calculated by the lists of opening, returning the route and its technical status, sub-regulation logs or according to passes given to cars going out from parking station for each day of the reporting period. If the car goes out from the parking station to the route (work) and is operated not less than 2 hours and returned to the parking station (regardless from the reason) is considered as working and is registered as one car-day in the work.</p> <p>Number of cars under repair according to days: calculates free hours of those cars of the organization, which were under repair in the reporting year or are to be repaired, regardless of the fact whether the repair is done in the repairing unit of the organization or at its repairing workshop.</p>

		<p>Cars waiting to be repaired are those cars, which are not operated in the routes because of technical problems, but were not sent for repair because of insufficient capacity of the repairing base, lack of necessary spare parts or other reasons. Moreover, only those cars are calculated which are under the repair or wait for the repair all day long. If the car has gone for route after being repaired and is operated for not less than 2 hours, is considered to be in operation on that day.</p> <p>Cars in the process of conservation are those cars, which are technically in a good condition. The conservation of cars is mainly connected with seasonal restriction of their use. For instance, the snow loading cars are mainly used in winter and are considered to be in the conservation during the other seasons of the year.</p> <p>Geographical coverage</p> <p>It covers the marzes of the Republic of Armenia and Yerevan city.</p> <p>Publication groupings</p> <p>The information on sanitary cleaning of urban areas is published according to urban areas of RA marzes and Yerevan.</p>
