0.6	Information Sources	The main source of indicator compilation is data collected from municipalities through statistical reports.
0.7	Legal Authority to Collect Data	The data are collected based on the Law on "Official Statistics" and "Five Year Statistical Program", as well as the Resolution No. 05-N of RA State Council on Statistics "On Approval of the Procedure for the collection of statistical data" dated 20 June 2016 and Resolution "On Approval of Annual Statistical Program".

1.1	Description of content	<p>The road improvement of urban communities includes the following:</p> <p>a) total length of streets and passages at the end of the year, including natural land and renovated (developed from the materials such as cement concrete, asphaltic concrete, amnestic and gravel (slag)</p> <p>b) the total area of streets, passages and squares (including sidewalks) (with and without coverage), including renovated ones</p> <p>c) receipt and use of financial means</p> <p>d) average listed number of employees</p>
1.2	Statistical concepts	<p>Main concepts</p> <p>Total length of all streets, passages – is the total length of all types of streets, i.e. renovated or non-renovated, including the length of bridges in the urban territories, crossroad bridges. If the active part of the street is divided into dividing structure or has a dividing line, the length of such street is calculated by its center, regardless of the number of traffic lines. By calculating the length of squares, it is considered as a crossroad of streets with two directions.</p> <p>Renovated streets are those streets, the traffic part of which is covered with both as renovated coverage and some type of non-renovated coverage.</p> <p>Total area of all streets, crossings and squares (including sidewalks) is the total area of all streets and passages located in the front parts of buildings (avenues, highways, alleys, blind alleys, squares, including territories near stations, sport squares, etc.), as well as the total area of bridges, crossroad bridges and their adjacent parts. The area of riverside streets is limited by the front parts of buildings (red line) and by the border of opposite side of the riverside street (baluster and</p>
