1.2	Statistical Concepts	Information on births is submitted by the regional Civil Registration Bodies of the RA Ministry of Justice (copy of the records). Since October 16, 2005 the definitions of WHO on life births, Stillbirths, Prenatal period serve as a basis for registration based on the 10th Review of Disease Classifications (RA Government Decision N949-N, June 16, 005). Life Births. The "Complete expulsion or extraction from its mother of a product of conception, which, after such separation, breathes or shows any other evidence of life such as the beating of the heart, pulsation of the umbilical cord, or definite movement of voluntary muscles, whether or not the umbilical cord has been cut or the placenta is attached". All the 500gr and over live birth cases are submitted to registration by regional Civil Registration Bodies.

2.2	Date of Publication	Quarterly indicators are published on the 30th day of the month following the reference period.
2.3	Punctuality	Data are published according to schedule of annual programs publication and no delays from defined deadlines have been recorded.

3.1	Overall Accuracy	There are no specific quantitative evaluations related to the overall accuracy. The obligatory provision of statistical reports by them is fixed in the legal acts regulating the statistics sector.

3.3	Measures on accuracy	The data of measures on accuracy submitted by organizations within the reference period of the current year is carried out by comparing them with the relevant data for the same period of the previous year.
