

Gender Issues

The global analysis of gender issues was given to the society at the UN Fourth World Conference on women's state held in Beijing, 1995, where the gender problems and program on further activities were also formed. Particularly, in the domain of information provision para. 206 of the Platform for Action defines that:

- the national, regional and international statistical services and relevant governmental and United Nations agencies, in cooperation with the research and documentation organizations in their respective areas of responsibility, should provide the collection, compiling, analyzing and presentation on a regular basis of data disaggregated by age and sex and reflect problems, issues and questions related to women and men in the society;
- and para. 207 defines that: the countries should ensure regular production of a statistical publication on gender that presents and interprets topical data on women and men in a form suitable for a wide range of non-technical users.
