

PART 6. DE JURE POPULATION MOVEMENT (MIGRATION)

Methodological clarifications

According to the methodological provisions of Population Censuses conduction, the continuity of person's residence in the given settlement was not dependent upon the availability of registration, its nature (permanent or temporary) and from the change of address within the boundaries of the same settlement.

The continuity of person's residence in the given settlement was not considered breached:

- in case of migration from one rural settlement to another within the boundaries of the same locality (former administrative district),
- in case of address change within the boundaries of the town/village,
- in case of compulsory military service and short-term business trip to abroad (up to one year) from the given residence,
- in all cases of departures from the given residence with duration of **less than one year** with no intention of changing the permanent residence (business trips, holidays, visits to friends, relatives, acquaintances etc.).

The continuity of person's residence in the given settlement was considered breached in all other cases including the migration **from rural settlement to town** or vice versa, as well as **from one town to another** in the same locality (former administrative district).
